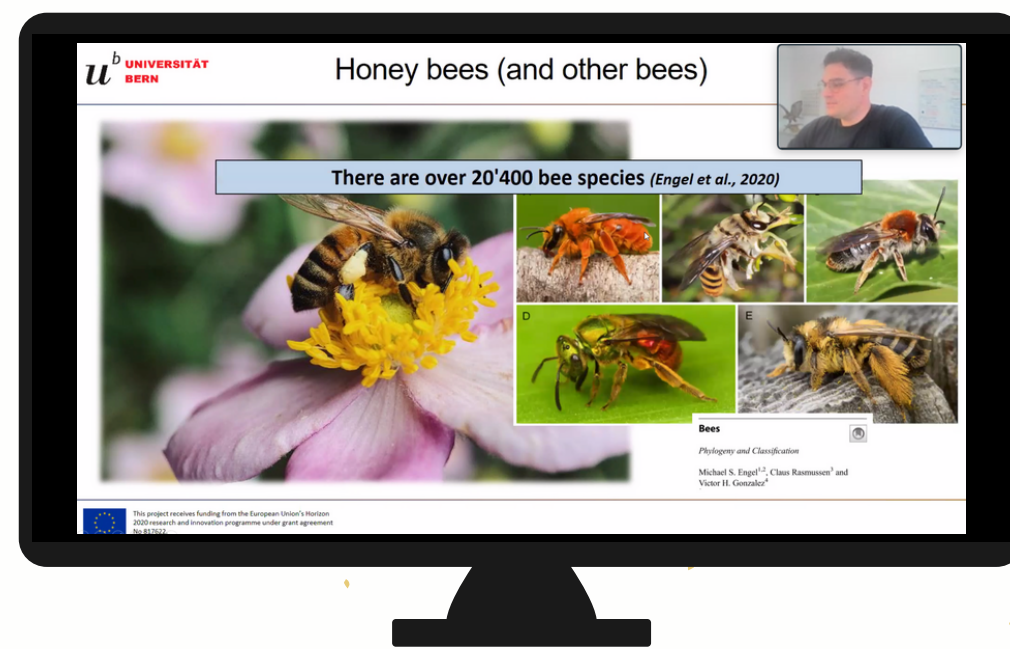




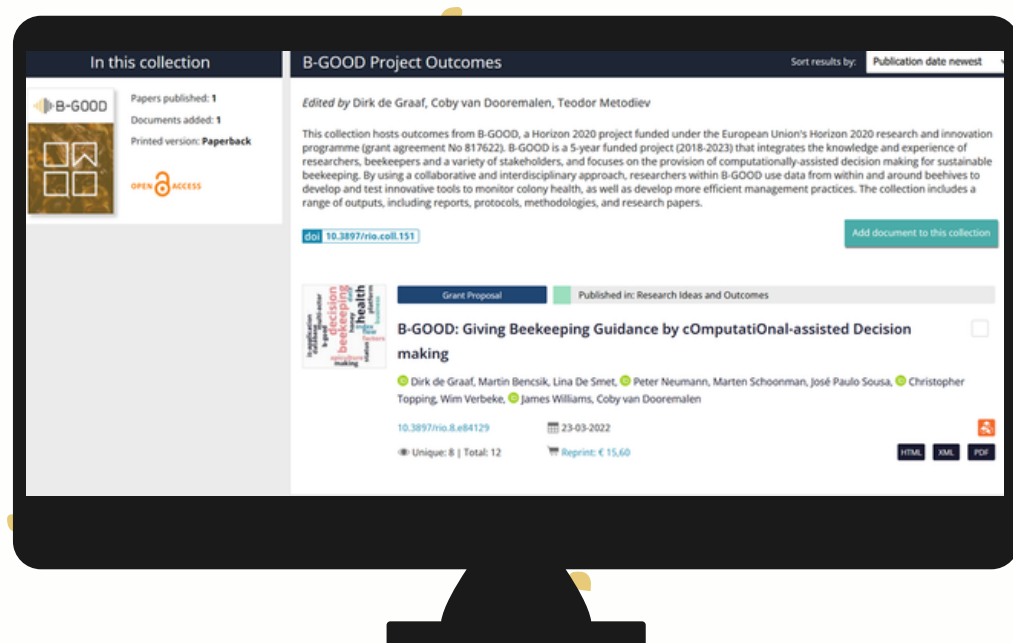
B-GOOD Online Honey Bee Course

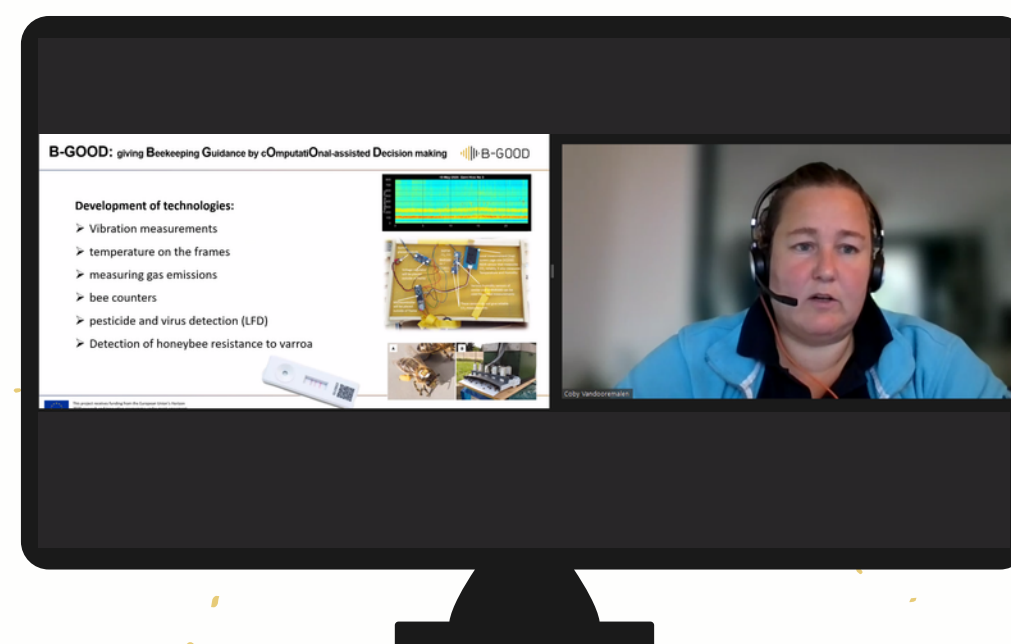


The BEEP app receives new functionalities!
